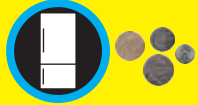

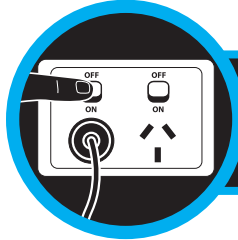
Here are some of our top ideas to help you use less power:



Turn off the lights and fans when you're not in the room



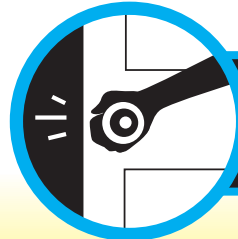
Turn off outside lights during the day

Use a fan to keep cool or set your aircon at 24°C or higher



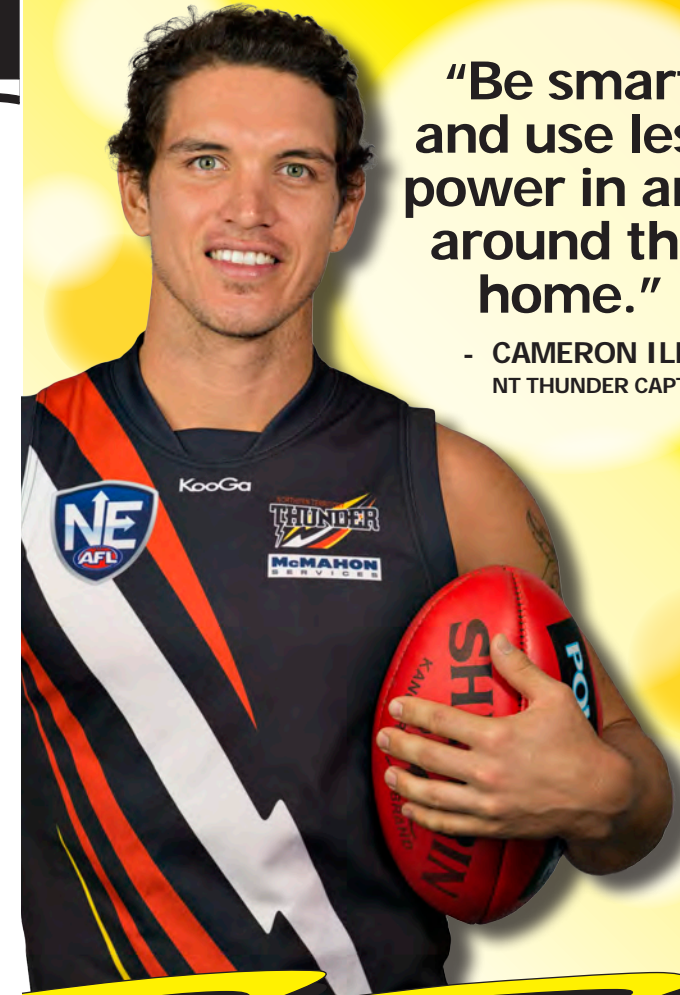
Shut all windows and doors when the aircon or heater is on

Turn off outside lights when you are inside (and during the day)

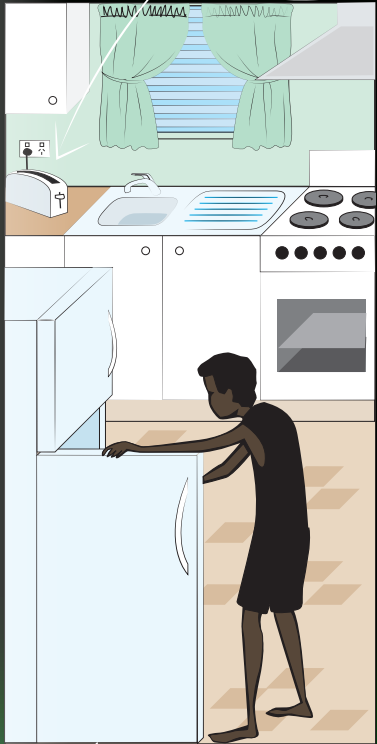
Turn appliances off at the wall when you're not using them

Turn off the lights, fans and TV when you're not in the room

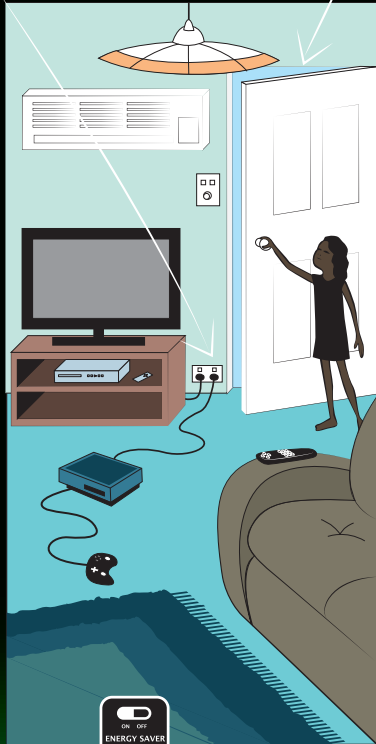
Shut all windows and doors when the aircon is on

Use a fan to keep cool

Clean your aircon filters



Shut the fridge door properly



Set the temperature of your fridge to the middle setting



Set your aircon at 24°C or higher and use a fan

Water after 8pm

Make sure your washing machine is full before you do the washing

Turn the tap off when you are not using it
