

Karama high voltage power cable replacement

The Power and Water Corporation is replacing a section of the high voltage underground cable supplying electricity to Karama. This will improve the long-term reliability of electricity supply to the area.

Work will start from Wednesday 16 February 2011 and take place in two stages over two months.

During the project it will be necessary to excavate the footpath or verge, including driveways, in order to locate and replace the high voltage cable along the following streets:

- Kalymnos Drive (Stage One)
- Manunda Terrace (Stage One and Two)
- Moray Street (Stage Two)
- Freycinet Street (Stage Two)

Access to some homes in these streets will be temporarily affected (see map on page 2).

Residents will be notified before any works start on driveways and every effort will be made to limit disruptions to less than 12 hours. In most cases access will be affected for two to three hours at a time.

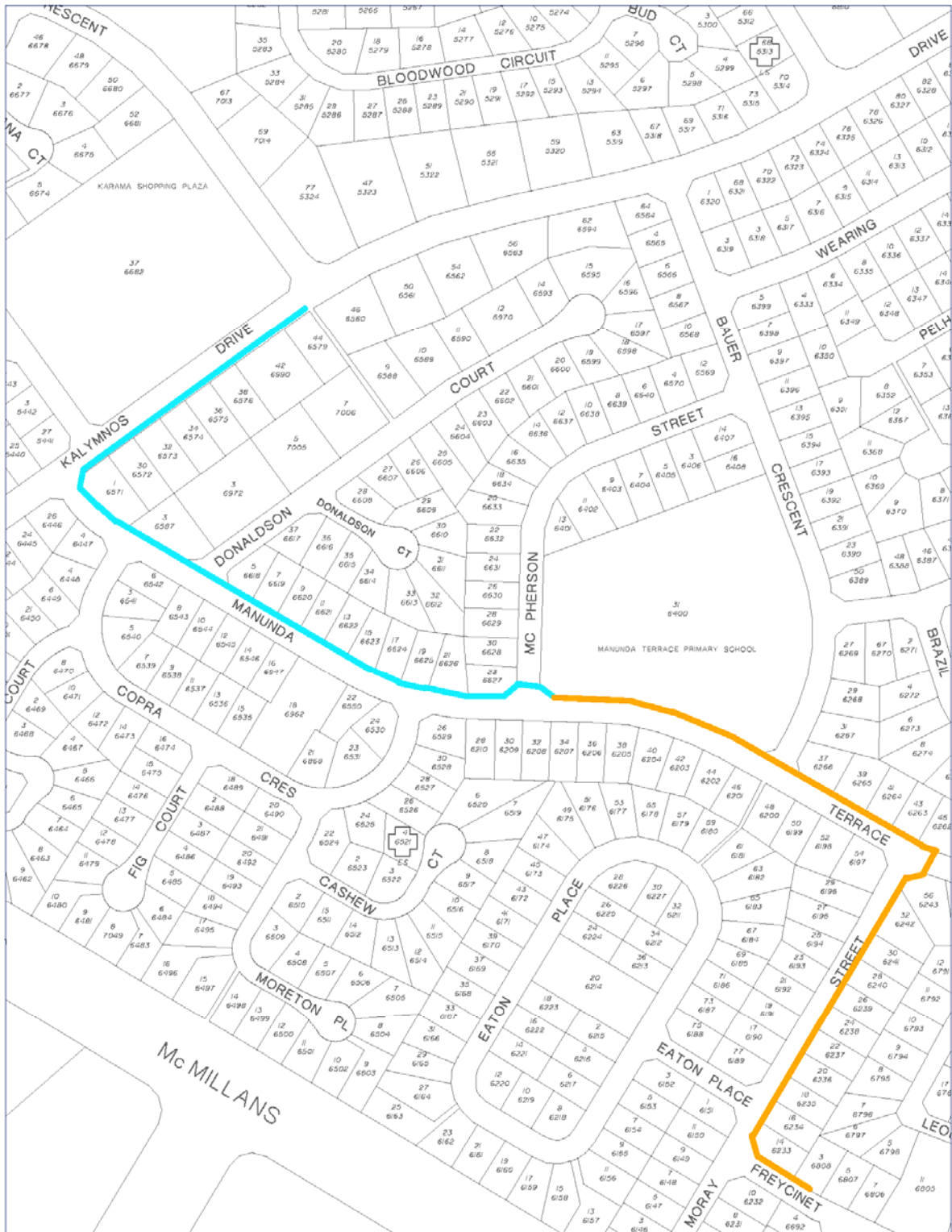
Residents needing to use their vehicles during the time their driveway will be affected, should make arrangements to park outside of the property. Pedestrian access to homes will not be affected.

It will also be necessary to prune and in some cases remove trees that have been planted over the underground cable on road verges. Power and Water will replace any trees that are removed during the project.

Once the upgrade is complete footpaths will be replaced, grassed verges that have been removed as part of the project will be re-seeded, and driveways will be reinstated.

As cable replacement is undertaken to improve electricity reliability every effort will be made to minimise the impact of these works on residents in the area.
