5. Any failure by the developer/contractor to provide any or all of the above that results in additional time or materials not included in the original quote provided by Power and Water, will incur additional costs for these works at either quoted or standard rates.
6. All work to be completed in accordance with the Power and Water Corporation Connection Code and to current Power and Water Standards.
7. A 24 month defects liability period for extension and subdivision and a 12 month defects liability period for building developments including single water services will commence once the certificate of final completion (Section 40) has been issued. All defect liabilities identified within this period is the responsibility of the developer. Any works subject to a defect during this period that requires Power and Water to undertake an emergency repair shall be subject to an extended defect period of 5 years.
