

Market Operator – NMI Allocation Procedure Consultation Feedback Assessment

Summary of issues raised in submissions from organisations represented in the stakeholder consultation process.

Consultation was conducted between 14 March 2016 and 11 April 2016.

No submissions were received from Market Participants.

It would be beneficial for maintenance and analysis to be able to easily recognise this group of customers by their NMI. The off-grid IES customers have been adequately catered for in this regard.	A block of 10,000 NMIs has been allocated to the on-grid IES customers in each power system. This change was made as note (c) in Appendix A.
