Who is eligible?

Any commercial operation, business, government or not-for-profit organisation in the Greater Darwin region is eligible for a free Water Use Health Check with Power and Water as long as they use less than 20 megalitres of water annually^{*}. If your business uses more than 20 megalitres per year than you are eligible for a Water Efficiency Consultation.

*Business and organisation must be connected to the reticulated town water supply (ie. not bore water).



Leaks

It appears that you may have a constant leak of about 230 litres per hour (equivalent to 25 buckets). The graph above should normally drop to zero at some stage throughout the day or night but consistent base flow has been identified that is likely costing your business around \$3,800 per year.

Garden Irrigation

It appears that you use about 59,000 litres per week on garden irrigation (equivalent to 245 wheelie bins). If this continued across seven-month period – like a typical dry season in the Top End – it would cost about \$3,300 per year.
