Connect

Living in the Territory is all about being ready for the worst that Mother Nature can throw at you.

A big part of that is staying **connected** with Power and Water and emergency authorities.



If the power goes out, wait **15 minutes** before calling us on **1800 245 090**. Chances are we're already on it.

Note In a cyclone or severe weather event, once we have received the all clear from the Disaster Coordinator, we need to evaluate the damage and make it safe before starting to design our restoration program. The first crews out after an event will be gathering information and isolating damage to make it safe. Essential and emergency services always take priority over residential properties.
