

# BE READY. BE SAFE.

Find key items in this picture that can help keep your family safe when severe weather hits.

- **Torch**  
Always use a battery-operated torch. Candles should not be used as they are a fire hazard.
- **Fallen powerlines**  
Fallen powerlines are always dangerous and don't always spark. Stay away and call Power and Water.
- **Power points**  
Power points and water do not mix! If a power point is wet, do not use it. Call an electrician to make it safe.
- **Battery-operated radio**  
Keep a battery-operated radio to stay up to date during a water or power outage.
- **Sewer overflow relief gully**  
Keep your sewer overflow relief gully clean and clear so sewage can overflow into your garden and not inside your home.
- **Phone**  
Use your phone to visit our website to stay updated on when power or water will be restored.
- **Bottles of water**  
This can be important if water supply is interrupted or drinking water becomes contaminated.
