

## Know what to do when **SEVERE WEATHER** comes through

Find key items in this picture that can help keep your family safe when severe weather hits.

- **Torch**  
Always use a battery-operated torch rather than candles, which can be a fire hazard.
- **Fallen powerlines**  
Stay away from fallen powerlines as they are dangerous and don't always spark. Call Power and Water.
- **Power points**  
Water and power points do not mix! If a power point is wet, do not use it. Call an electrician to make it safe.
- **Battery-operated radio**  
Invest in a battery-operated radio to stay up to date during a water or power outage.
- **Sewer overflow relief gully**  
Keep your sewer overflow relief gully clean and clear so sewage can overflow into your garden and not inside your home.
- **Phone**  
Visit our website from your phone, to stay updated on when power or water will be restored.
- **Bottles of water**  
Stock up on bottled water in case your water supply is interrupted or the drinking water becomes contaminated.
